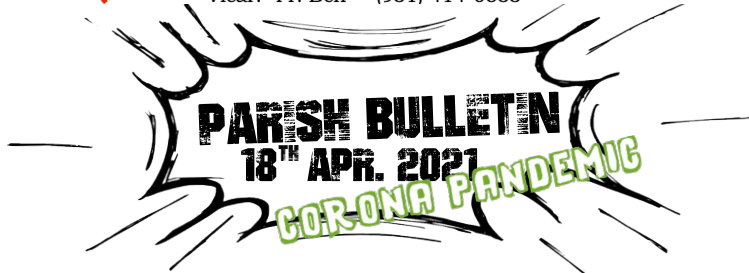

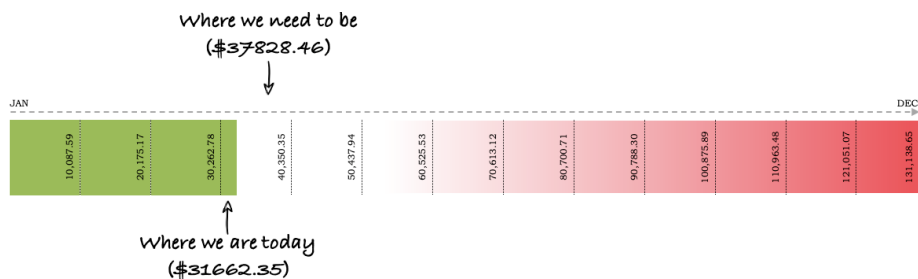

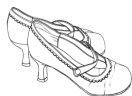
### Theme: 'TERRIFIED' OF JESUS
