Starting today, the offering-plate will be circulated. Please be prepared.

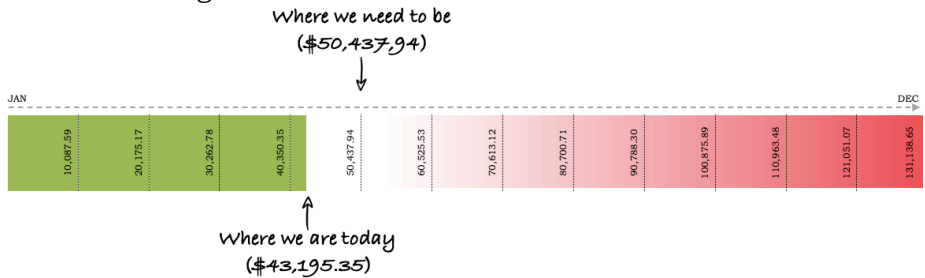
